Principles of providing employees with work clothing and footwear and supplying them with personal protective equipment against hazardous and health-damaging factors occurring in the work environment

I. Table of standard allowances for personal protective equipment and work clothing and footwear

Meanings of symbols and characters in the table:

- W.P. winter period from 1 November to 31 March (5 months);
- **T.B.U.** to be used, i.e., use of:
 - 1) personal safety equipment until such time as its protective properties are lost or, if its useful life is specified by the manufacturer, no longer than that period;
 - 2) work clothing and footwear until such time as they lose their functional qualities to the extent that repair is not possible;
- * to be issued in rooms where the following temperature is not ensured:
 - 1) min. 18 degrees C (291 K) for office and light physical work;
 - 2) min. 14 degrees C (287 K) for other work and outdoor work;
- ** to be issued according to the needs resulting from the conditions (place and type) of work performed / in the case of safety gloves to be selected and issued according to the hazards present at the workplace and other guidelines;
- *** to be issued only to employees permanently engaged in standing work in the building;
- **** to be issued when outdoor work in the field;
- ***** applies to the Industrial Research Laboratory;

duty (adjective) – assigned to a unit, not to an employee;

m – month.

work (occupational) footwear – footwear with safety features intended to protect the wearer against injuries which might occur during a workplace accident.

safety footwear – footwear for use at work; footwear with safety features and toe caps, the durability of which is tested at an 100J impact point. Designed to protect the wearer from injuries that may occur during a workplace accident.

EXPLANATION:

The expected service life in months or in winter periods specified in the standards table is helpful in determining the quantitative and assortment needs in the organizational units. In justified cases, if work clothes, footwear and personal safety equipment are in satisfactory condition, the head may extend the useful life of this equipment.

If an employee performs additional activities in addition to the basic activities prescribed for a specific position, which require additional equipment according to the standards table, it is obligatory to supplement the employee's equipment to the extent of the standard applicable to

the position (e.g. a mechanic who performs continuous welding work, a driver who performs continuous mechanical work).

II. Personal hygiene products allowance standards

- Individual standards for the allocation of personal hygiene products should meet the actual
 needs resulting from the nature of employment and working conditions, i.e. in establishing
 them, it is necessary to take into account the degree of soiling of the body and health risks
 resulting from factors occurring in the working environment and the sanitary regulations in
 force in a given organizational unit.
- 2. Minimum standards of personal hygiene products allowance for one employee working permanently on exceptionally dirty jobs:
 - 1) Exceptionally dirty jobs that cause heavy hand soiling:
 - 100 grams (one bar) of hard toilet soap per month or liquid soap in individual packages in an amount equivalent to the effectiveness of hard soap;
 - 1 package of HSW paste per month;
 - 2 medium-sized cloth towels per year;
 - 1 packet of hand protection cream per month.
 - 2) jobs that cause soiling of the whole body:
 - 200 grams (two bars) of hard toilet soap per month or liquid soap in individual packages in an amount equivalent to the effectiveness of hard soap;
 - 1 package of HSW paste per month;
 - 2 medium-sized cloth towels per year;
 - 1 packet of hand protection cream per month.
 - 3) jobs involving body soiling with substances that are difficult to clean, such as oil paints and varnishes, tar and adhesives, petroleum distillation products, and work with skin-damaging substances:
 - 200 grams (two bars) of hard toilet soap per month or liquid soap in individual packages in an amount equivalent to the effectiveness of hard soap;
 - 1 package of HSW paste per month;
 - 2 medium-sized cloth towels per year;
 - 1 packet of hand protection cream per month;
 - 1 packet of regenerative hand cream per month.

- 4) for other jobs not specified in points 1, 2 and 3:
- 100 grams (one bar) of hard toilet soap per month or liquid soap in individual packages in an amount equivalent to the effectiveness of hard soap;
- 1 medium-sized cloth towel per year;
- 1 packet of hand protection cream per month.
- 3. Employees in jobs other than those in sections 2 who use public toilets equipped with washing, drying and toilet paper shall not be entitled to individual personal hygiene products allowances.
