Decision no. 118/2023
of the Warsaw University of Technology Rector
of 16 May 2023

on the tuition fees for education in the academic year 2023/2024 payable by Polish citizens and citizens of European Union member states, the Swiss Confederation and member states of the European Free Trade Association (EFTA) – parties to the agreement on the European Economic Area and members of their families, citizens of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland referred to in Art. 10 section 1 letter b or d of the Agreement on the withdrawal of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland from the European Union and the European Atomic Energy Community (Journal of Acts EU L 29 of 31.01.2020, page 7) and members of their families, living in the territory of the Republic of Poland

Pursuant to Art. 23 section 1, Art. 79 section 1 points 1-4 and Art. 80 of the Act of 20 July 2018 – Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Acts of 2023 item 742, as amended), and Art. 264 of the Act of 3 July 2018 Implementing provisions to the Act – Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Acts item 1669, as amended), in view of the costs of education calculated in accordance with Regulation no. 29/2021 of the Warsaw University of Technology Rector of 14 April 2021 on costs of education in full-time degree programmes and fees payable for education and other educational services at the Warsaw University of Technology, and the costs of implementation of the Development Strategy of the Warsaw University of Technology until 2030, it is hereby determined as follows:

§ 1

1. The following tuition fees in the academic year 2023/2024 are laid down:
 - 1) tuition fees for:
 - a) tuition in part-time programmes;
 - b) tuition in full-time programmes in English as the language of instruction; in accordance with Annex no. 1;
 - 2) tuition fees for retaking courses in full-time programmes due to unsatisfactory progress in learning, in accordance with Annex no. 2;
 - 3) tuition fees for courses not included in the study programme, in accordance with Annex no. 3.
2. The tuition fees included herein shall apply:
 - 1) for the whole duration of the study to students admitted in the academic year 2023/2024, who are citizens of European Union member states, the Swiss Confederation and member states of the European Free Trade Association (EFTA) – parties to the agreement on the European Economic Area and members of their families, citizens of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland referred to in Art. 10 section 1 letter b or d of the Agreement on the withdrawal of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland from the European Union and the European Atomic Energy Community (Journal of Acts EU L 29 of 31.01.2020, page 7) and members of their families, living in the territory of the Republic of Poland; this shall not apply to increased tuition fees for courses not included in the study programme.
 - 2) in the academic year 2023/2024, to students admitted to degree programmes pursuant to regulations valid in the academic year 2018/2019 or earlier:
 - a) students who are Polish citizens,
 - b) students who are foreigners and were admitted to degree programmes "on the basis of regulations applicable to Polish citizens" laid down in Art. 43 section 2 of the Act of 27 July 2005 – Law on Higher Education (Journal of Acts of 2017, item 2183, as amended);

The decision enters into force on the day of its signing.

II. Part-time programmes – courses taken in advance, make-up courses, retaken courses, resumption of study

1. Subject to sections 3-4, the individual semester tuition fee (k_s) for part-time programmes according to the study plan applicable to a student in a given semester, is determined with the following formula:

$$k_s = \frac{k_n \cdot l.sem.}{n ECTS} \cdot l ECTS$$

where:

k_s –	individual tuition fee for a given semester,
k_n –	semester fee for the study (tuition fee),
$l.sem.$ –	number of semesters determined in the study programme,
$n ECTS$ –	number of ECTS determined in the study programme,
$l ECTS$ –	total number of ECTS for courses completed by the student from the study programme for a given semester (i.e., in the semester he/she is registered on), from previous and subsequent semesters, and also make-up courses determined by the Dean of the Faculty, both those completed for the first time and those retaken.

2. In justified cases, the Dean may apply to the Rector to make the formula laid down in section 1 more detailed.
3. The tuition fees for part-time programmes in case **the diploma semester is retaken**, in case consultations on the diploma thesis are needed or in case **consultations of term papers are retaken** in first- and second-cycle study.

III. Full-time degree programmes in English as the language of instruction – courses taken for the first time

The individual tuition fee for full-time degree programmes in English as the language of instruction (k_{sang}) if the student **for the first time** takes courses from previous and subsequent semesters (e.g. courses taken in advance), as well as make-up courses determined by the Dean, are determined with the following formula:

$$k_{sang} = \frac{k_{nang} \cdot l.sem.}{n ECTS} \cdot l ECTS$$

where:

k_{sang} –	individual tuition fee for a given semester,
k_{nang} –	semester fee for the study (tuition fee),
$l.sem.$ –	number of semesters determined in the study programme,
$n ECTS$ –	number of ECTS determined in the study programme,
$l ECTS$ –	total number of ECTS for courses completed by the student from the study programme for a given semester (i.e., in the semester he/she is registered on), from previous and subsequent semesters, and also make-up courses determined by the Dean of the Faculty, both those completed for the first time and those retaken.

**Amounts of fees for retaking certain courses in full-time programmes
due to unsatisfactory learning progress in the academic year 2023/2024**

1. The fee for retaking a course is the sum of fees for courses other than lectures (the product of the number of hours multiplied by the fee for one hour of the retaken course) and the lump sum for the lecture (if it is foreseen in the study programme for a given course).
2. If a course is failed, the fee for retaking the course is determined pursuant to sections 3 and 4, taking into consideration the number of hours for the course determined in the study programme. The fee for retaking the course is due if the same or equivalent course is retaken.
